

Bumper Boat Safety

Follow these guidelines to make your ride in Home Run Harbor a fun one!

- Adults must accompany children under 5 years of age
- You must be 6 years old and 44” tall to drive alone
- Maximum weight allowed per boat is 425 lbs.
- All riders under 48” tall must wear a life vest and be accompanied by an adult
- No swimming or diving—pond depth only 3 ft.
- Remain seated at all times—no riding on seat backs
- No smoking, No food or drink in the pond area
- No running, pushing or horseplay allowed
- Keep all loose clothing away from motor
- No one under the influence of alcohol or drugs allowed
- We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone
- Not responsible for lost or damaged articles
- No splashing—Keep arms and hands in the boat at all times
